## SPORTS LOTTERY GAME CONDITION CHANGES



## CHANGES EFFECTIVE APRIL 3, 2009

The following apply to PRO•LINE, POINT SPREAD or PRO•PICKS (with the exception of car racing on PRO•PICKS POOLS).

### GAME CONDITION CHANGE 1

An event is considered incomplete when the game is not completed in regulation play (or extra play, or a shoot-out, if any) prior to 5 a.m. Eastern Time on the day following the original scheduled date.

#### PRO•LINE EXAMPLE >>>

- A baseball game was rained out after only 4 innings were completed.
- The score was Visitor 4, Home 5.
- The game was cancelled and rescheduled to play the next day at 3:00 p.m.

Therefore, since the game is not finished before 5:00 a.m. on the day following the scheduled start time, all outcomes (V+, V, T, H, H+) would be considered correct and odds would revert to 1.00.

### GAME CONDITION CHANGE 2

When two games between the same two teams are played in one day, neither (the first or second) game will be considered the event originally scheduled for that date, and the event originally scheduled for that date will be considered an incomplete event.

#### PRO•LINE EXAMPLE >>>

- A Saturday game is not played and is scheduled as a double header on Sunday.
- The Saturday game would be considered incomplete and all outcomes would revert to 1.00.
- If any wagers were accepted for either game played on Sunday, the games would then be considered incomplete and all outcomes would revert to 1.00, as well.
